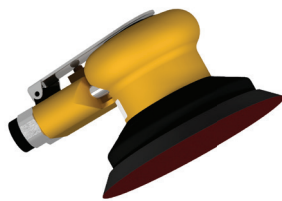


Glass Cleaning Guide

and Rag

Things to Know Before You Get Started

- This guide is designed to show you how to clean dirty glass or remove light scrapes or scratches
- These can stem from the manufacturing process, transportation, installation, or daily use



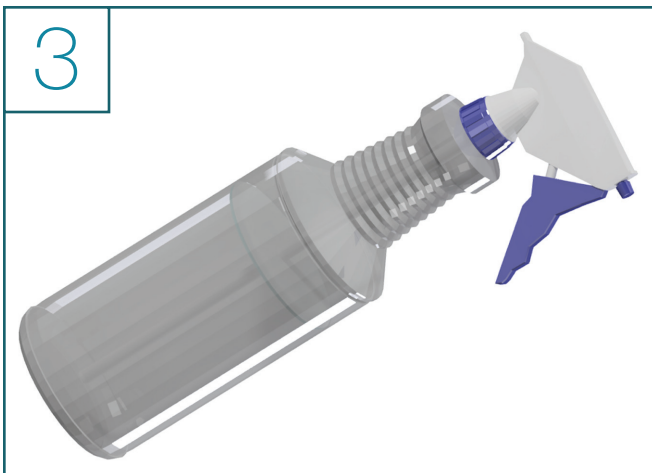
Dirty Glass Cleaning Process



- Cleaning glass with production waste or grime that standard cleaning products do not remove can be easily done with a rag, cleaning compound, and water (preferably a spray bottle)



- First apply the compound with the rag to the dirty areas and rub it in with a circular motion

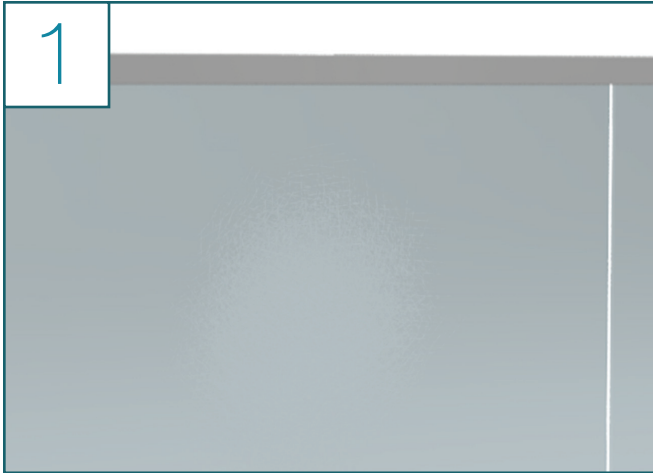


- Next use your water or spray bottle and spray the compound and continue wiping in a circular motion
- Wipe all the compound and water off with a clean rag
- In most cases this will remove glass blemishes



- Finally wipe the remainder of the glass clean with a fresh rag
- If the glass seems like it has some of the compound on it or it is a little hazy, you can use Windex or your preferred glass cleaner to make it shiny again

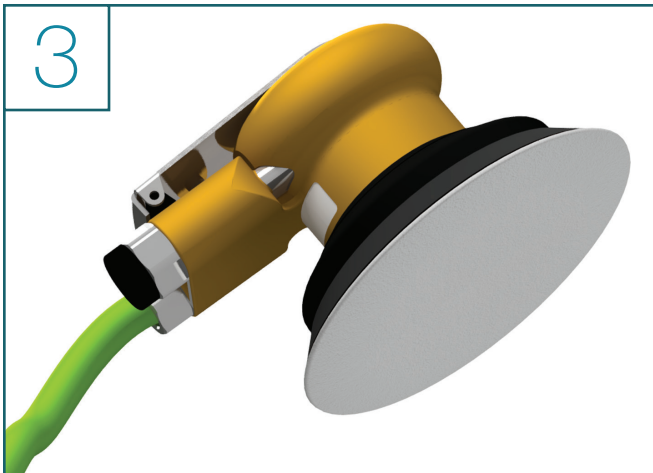
Light Scratches Removal Process



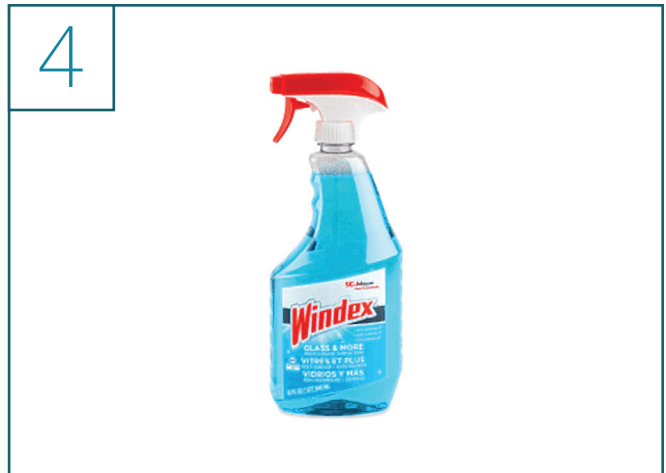
- Sometimes your glass has deeper scratches or abrasions that need buffed out
- These steps will help you remove any surface blemishes that may occur during shipping and/or installation



- Apply the Cleaning Compound to the glass panel



- Using the Orbital Sander and the provided buffing pad, start your orbital sander and work in a slow circular motion



- You can now clean and dry the glass with a clean rag and your favorite cleaning solution
